CALIFORNIA EMPLOYER PULL NOTICE (EPN) PROGRAM SERVICE	California Vehicle Code 1808.1 requires employers who have CDL drivers who regularly operate in California to participate in an ongoing review of driver records.	We will enroll your drivers in accordance with the requirements of this program.
