## **Spill Prevention Control & Countermeasures (SPCC)**

> Ongoing onsite guidance and resources for improving compliance

Under EPA regulations, if you store more than 1,320 gallons of oil in drums 55 gallons and larger, or if you store more than 42,000 gallons of oil underground, you are required to have a Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasures Plan (SPCC) in place. An SPCC plan is a detailed, facility-specific, written description of how a facility's operations meet the prevention measures outlined in the regulations.

J. J. Keller and U.S. Compliance have a trained staff to help you comply with the requirements. We will visit your facility to conduct an onsite inspection to identify any deficiencies and to prepare and file the facility diagram. Once the inspection is complete, we'll prepare an SPCC plan in accordance with the regulations. A registered Professional Engineer (PE) will verify that the plan complies with the regulations.

- Facility drainage
- Bulk storage containers
- Monthly facility inspection checklist
- Notification reportable spill events
- SPCC training records
- SPCC action plan
- Drainage event record



The rules (40CFR 112) apply to all types of sites, including industrial sites, commercial sites, retail locations, offices, restaurants, hotels, construction sites, farms and municipal properties.
