SARA Title III/EPCRA was implemented to create a cooperative relationship among government, business, and the public, involving them in the effort to prevent, plan, prepare for, and manage chemical emergencies.

Annually by March 1, all owners and operators of manufacturing and non-manufacturing facilities with one or more covered hazardous chemicals are required to report chemical inventory data to their local fire departments, local emergency planning committees, and state emergency response commissions.

- Physical and health hazards
- Maximum and average daily amounts
- Storage types, conditions, and locations
- Additional information verifying reporting status
